Read Jeremiah 32

In this sermon, you're invited to reflect on the challenges of decision-making in a world filled with constant noise and distractions. Pastor Jim highlights the importance of seeking clarity from God in your life. Through the story of Jeremiah's purchase of a field in a turbulent city, you're encouraged to follow three key steps to live in accordance with God's plan:

- 1. Listen to God:** The sermon underscores the significance of actively listening to God. It's essential to approach Him with an open heart and mind, ready to hear His guidance, even if it doesn't align with your preconceived notions.
- 2. Discern God's Guidance:** Recognizing God's voice amidst the myriad of influences is crucial. The sermon advises you to discern whether it's God speaking or if other factors are at play, such as your own desires, external pressures, or even negative influences like the devil.
- 3. Take Action:** You're encouraged to act on what you believe God is guiding you to do. The sermon emphasizes the importance of not just seeking guidance but also being proactive in following that guidance. When God speaks, trust and take that first step in faith.

Remember, finding clarity in a chaotic world is possible when you actively engage with God, listen to His guidance, discern His voice, and take bold action, even when it seems unconventional.

Questions for reflection:

1. How do you personally define "listening to God" and what practices or experiences have helped you in this process?
2. Can you think of a time when you had to discern whether a decision was guided by God, your own desires, or external influences? What factors helped you make that decision?
3. Think about a challenging decision you're currently facing. What steps can you take to actively seek God's guidance in this situation, and how might you overcome any preconceived ideas or biases?

4. What are some of the common barriers that prevent you from taking action on what you believe to be God's guidance? How can these obstacles be overcome?

5. Is there any examples of someone you know who took a bold step in faith, following what they believed was God's guidance, even when it seemed unconventional. What lessons can you draw from their experience?
