

Bringing Light to Our Shadows: A Message of Hope

Read Joshua 7

The sermon discusses the harm that hidden sin can cause and the importance of bringing it into the open before God. Through the story of Achan in Joshua 7, we see Achan's secret disobedience led to Israel's defeat at Ai, showing how hidden wrongdoing affects not just the individual but the wider community. The Israelites, confident after their victory at Jericho, neglected to seek God's guidance, and as a result, they faced unnecessary consequences due to Achan's actions.

The message encourages us to understand that when sin is kept hidden, it can quietly grow and impact not only our own lives but also those around us. Achan's actions led to fear and loss, serving as a reminder that even small things kept in the dark can have big effects. As Christians we need to seek healing and freedom by confessing our struggles and finding support through our faith, which reminds us that God's forgiveness and grace are available when we bring our burdens and sin to Him.

- 5. In what ways can I trust God more with the areas of my life I'm afraid to reveal?
